### **Position Description:**

The Leadership Candidate will have responsibility as the overall lead, manager and administrator for IT infrastructure development and operations maintenance contract efforts.

### **Duties and qualifications, identifying both essential and marginal duties:**

- Serve as the primary interface and point of contact with Government program authorities and representatives on technical and program/project issues.
- Will supervise contractor personnel and program/project operations by developing procedures; planning and directing execution of the technical, programming, maintenance, and administrative support effort; and monitoring and reporting progress.
- Candidate will manage acquisition and employment of program/project resources and control financial and administrative aspects of the program/project with respect to contract requirements.
- Responsible for opening new conversations between existing partners and hiring managers and closing deals.

### **Education, Skill, and Experience Requirements:**

- Fifteen (15) years of Defense acquisition process experience and six (6) years of supervisory experience are required.
- Demonstrable experience in proposal preparation.
- Demonstrable ability to work in fast changing environments.
- Experience with Service Oriented Architecture (SOA) and NGA service areas (Common Services, Storage Services, Enterprise Management, Application Hosting, and Transport Services)
- Experience interfacing internally and externally at all levels including senior management.
- Experience mentoring other Program Managers and directing and coaching project engineers.

- Willingness to take ownership of the program with minimal oversight.
